

AN ACT to further amend The Waste Lands Act. [27 December, 1872.]

W HEREAS it is expedient to further amend The Waste Lands Act: PREAMBLE. Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, 34 Vict. No. 10. by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in The Waste "Quiet Enjoy-Lands Act, it shall be lawful for the Commissioner to offer for sale by ment" pastoral lands may be sold auction, and to sell, any Pastoral Waste Lands of the Crown held by any before survey. person for "Quiet Enjoyment" under the Regulations for the Disposal of the Waste Lands of the Crown dated the First day of November, 1851, and published in the Gazette on the Fourth day of the same month, although such lands or any of them have not previously to any sale by auction been surveyed and delineated in the public charts of the Colony, in such lots as are subsequently offered and put up for sale, in manner directed by the Thirty-second Section of the said Act; and all the provisions of the said Act, save so far as is herein otherwise provided, shall be applicable to the sale and disposal of any lands hereinbefore mentioned.

- 2 This Act and The Waste Lands Act, and any Act altering or Acts to be read amending the same, shall, save so far as altered or amended by this Act, together. be read and construed together as one Act.
 - 3 This Act may be cited as "The Waste Lands Act, 1872."
