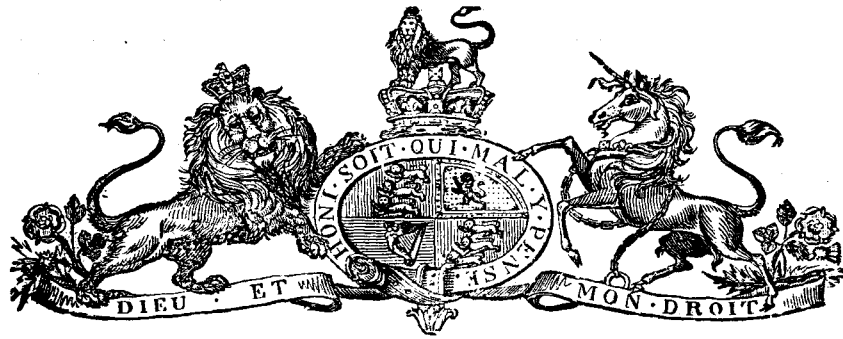

AN ACT to further amend *The Waste Lands Act*. A.D. 1880.
[11 March, 1880.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 So much of the unimproved Waste Lands of the Crown at *Tasman's Peninsula* as the Governor in Council may by Proclamation from time to time specify and appoint, shall be open to selection and purchase by private contract under the 24th Section of *The Waste Lands Act*, in the same manner in all respects and subject to the same conditions as Agricultural Land may be selected and purchased by private contract under the said Section, anything contained in "An Act to make provision for the Alienation of the Lands of the Crown at *Tasman's Peninsula*" to the contrary notwithstanding. Land at *Tasman's Peninsula* may be open to selection and purchase by private contract. 38 Vict. No. 18.

2 The provisions contained in Sections Twenty-eight and Twenty-nine of *The Waste Lands Act* shall be applicable to all land selected and purchased by private contract under the last preceding Section of this Act. Application of Sections 28 and 29 of 34 Vict. No. 10.

3 The provisions contained in Section Thirty-eight of *The Waste Lands Act* shall be applicable to all land sold by auction under the Act of the 38th *Victoria*, No. 18. Sec. 38 of 34 Vict. No. 10 applicable to land sold under 38 Vict. No. 18.

Aid to Road
Trusts.

4 It shall not be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer to pay to the Trustees of the several Road Districts of this Colony in respect of the Year 1880 any greater sum than that set apart under the provisions of the Ninety-ninth Section of the Waste Lands Act.

Accounts, &c. to
be forwarded to
Treasurer before
31st *March*, 1881.

5 All such accounts, returns, and documents as the Colonial Treasurer may require for the purpose of ascertaining the amount payable to such Trustees shall be forwarded to him on or before the Thirty-first day of *March* in the year 1881, and the Trustees of any Road District failing to furnish such accounts, returns, and documents shall not share in the distribution of any moneys as hereinbefore provided.

Certain land
abutting on
George Town
Road may be sold.

6 It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to sell by private contract for cash and at a sum not less than Four Shillings per foot frontage, to any person or persons whose land or lands may abut thereon, so much of the land heretofore used, reserved, or set apart for any drain, ditch, or sewer, along the western side of the *George Town* Road in the Town of *Launceston* extending from the Esplanade on the *North Esk River* to the angle of *Forster-street* with that road: Provided nevertheless, that no building or erection whatsoever shall be built or put on any land sold under this Section; and every Deed of Grant of any such land shall contain a condition prohibiting the building or putting up of any building or erection as aforesaid.

Upon the breach of any condition contained in any such grant deed, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, by proclamation published in the *Gazette*, to declare such grant deed null and void; and from and after the date of such proclamation the land held under any grant deed so declared null and void shall revert in Her Majesty and become Waste Lands of the Crown.

Acts to be read
together.

7 This Act and *The Waste Lands Act*, and every Act altering or amending the same, shall, save so far as altered or amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act.

Short Title.

8 This Act may be cited as "The Waste Lands Act, 1880."
