

AN ACT to further amend The Waste Lands Act. A.D. 1880. [11 March, 1880.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 So much of the unimproved Waste Lands of the Crown at Tasman's Land at Tasman's Peninsula as the Governor in Council may by Proclamation from time to Peninsula may be time specify and appoint, shall be open to selection and purchase by private contract under the 24th Section of *The Waste Lands Act*, in the same manner in all respects and subject to the same conditions of the same manner in all respects and subject to the same conditions as Agricultural Land may be selected and purchased by private contract under the said Section, anything contained in "An Act to make provision for 38 Vict.
