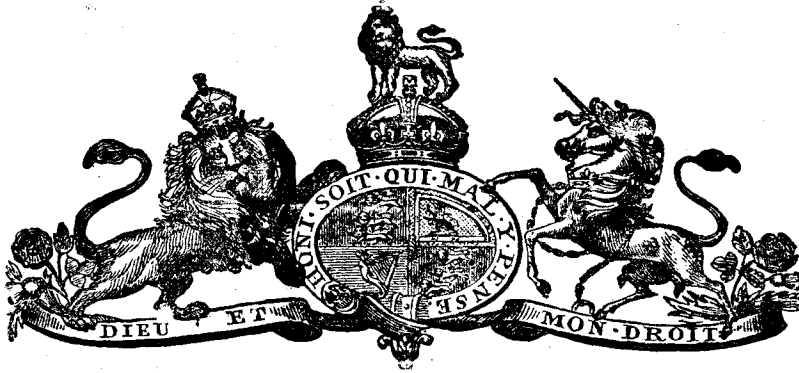

AN ACT to authorise the Town Board of the Town of *Zeehan* to purchase certain Rights, and to authorise the loan of Five thousand five hundred Pounds to the said Board in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890."

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as "The *Zeehan* Town Board Loan Act, Short title. 1906."

**2** In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines—

"Board" shall mean the Town Board of the Town of *Zeehan* :

"The said business" shall mean all the property, both real and personal, of the *Zeehan* Electric Light and Power Company, Limited (In Liquidation), and all its choses in action, and

all rights, privileges, and concessions granted to *Percy John Edward Fowler* by "The *Zeehan* Electric Light and Power Act, 1898," and now possessed by the said Company.

**3** It shall be lawful for the Board to purchase the said business.

**4** It shall be lawful for the Board to borrow any sum or sums, not exceeding in the whole Five thousand five hundred Pounds, for the purpose of defraying the cost of purchasing the said business and of adding to and improving the same.

**5** It shall be lawful for the Governor to grant, in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," the sum of Five thousand five hundred Pounds as a loan to the Board for the purposes set forth in the Section Four hereof.

**6** The poll of the ratepayers of the Town of *Zeehan* taken on the Twenty-fifth day of *April*, One thousand nine hundred and six, is hereby declared to be a sufficient approval of the said loan and purchase to satisfy the requirements of all Acts requiring a poll in that behalf.

produce plans,  
&c.

**7** It shall not be necessary to produce in Parliament or elsewhere any plans or specifications of the works connected with the said business or any reports thereon: Provided that no part of the said sum of Five thousand five hundred Pounds shall be paid to the Board until the Engineer-in-Chief shall have certified that he is satisfied with the manner in which the Board proposes to spend the same.

Board to become

**8** The Board shall upon completion of the purchase of the said business become the Projector under "The *Zeehan* Electric Light and Power Act, 1898," and shall have all the powers of the said Projector in addition to its powers as a Town Board.
