AN ACT to amend the Vermin Destruction Act 1950.

114 October 1976

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Vermin Destruction Act Short title and 1976.
- (2) The Vermin Destruction Act 1950, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Interpretation.

2 Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of "Fund".

Suppression of vermin on Crown land.

- **3** Section 10 of the Principal Act is amended—
- (a) by omitting from subsection (2) the words "; but where any such arrangement is entered into, the Director of Lands shall pay to the credit of the Fund the amount of the costs and expenses (as certified by the Director) incurred in the destruction of vermin and cover pursuant to the arrangement"; and
- (b) by omitting from subsection (3) the words ", and all amounts required by subsection (2) of this section to be paid to the credit of the Fund,".

Vermin Destruction Fund.

4 Section 18 of the Principal Act is repealed.

Disposal of residual money.

5 Any money standing to the credit of the Fund immediately prior to the commencement of this Act shall, as soon as practicable after the commencement of this Act, be paid into Consolidated Revenue.
