### ANALYSIS

**AN ACT to amend the Weights and Measures Act 1934.**

**[10 June 1976]**

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1—**(1) This Act may be cited as the *Weights and Measures Act* Short title and citation. 1976.

(2) The *Weights and Measures Act* 1934, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

## Regulations.

**2** Section 41 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting “ and ” at the end of paragraph (o);
- (b) by inserting after that paragraph the following paragraph:—
  - “(oa) Prescribing or restricting the units of measurement of a physical quantity that may be used in respect of the sale, advertising, and display of an article of any description; and ”; and
- (c) by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—
  - “(2) The regulations made for the purposes of subsection (1) (o) or (oa) may make different provisions with respect to different parts of the State or may apply only to defined parts thereof.”.
