

WAGES BOARDS.

No. 75 of 1963.

AN ACT to amend the *Wages Boards Act 1920*.
[3 December 1963.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Wages Boards Act 1963*.

(2) The *Wages Boards Act 1920*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Remuneration
of members

2 Section twelve of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in subsection (1) thereof, after the word “fees”, the words “, allowances, and sums by way of reimbursement of expenses”.

Application
of certain
provisions of
the *Evidence
Act 1910*.

3 Section twenty-four of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting therefrom the word “The” and substituting therefor the words “Subject to this section, the”; and

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

“(2) Notwithstanding anything in subsection (1) of this section or in the *Evidence Act 1910*, persons who attend before a board for the purpose of giving evidence when summoned so to do shall be paid such fees, allowances, and sums by way of reimbursement of expenses as may be prescribed under this Act.”.
