AN ACT to amend the *Workers' Compensation Act 1927*.
[25 November, 1943.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Workers' Compensation Act 1943*. Short title.

Section 34.**2** The Principal Act is hereby amended—

I. By expunging paragraph VI. of subsection (3) of section four thereof:

II. By inserting after subsection (8) of section thirty-four thereof the following new subsections (9) and (10)—

“(9) Every employer to whom a policy of insurance has been issued for the purposes of this section shall furnish to the insurer not later than twenty-one days after the expiration or sooner determination of such policy a statement in such form as the insurer may require containing full particulars of all wages paid to such workers by such employer during the period for which such policy was in force.

Penalty: Twenty Pounds.

(10) Every employer applying for a policy of insurance for the purposes of this section, or to whom such a policy has been issued, shall furnish to the insurer, in writing, full particulars of all workers employed by him who are members of his family dwelling in his house, and of the wages paid to such workers—

I. At the time such application is made: and

II. Within twenty-one days after any such employment has commenced during the currency of such policy.

Penalty: Ten Pounds.”:

III. By deleting the word “three” in paragraph II. of subsection (1) of section 2 of the schedule thereto and substituting “four”.
