Section 3.

I. By adding at the end of the title the words “and certain articles of clothing.”:

II. By adding at the end of section three thereof the words “and to suits and costumes which are not tailor-made as defined in the regulations.”: and

Section 4.

III. By inserting at the end of section four thereof the following new subsection (2):—

“(2) No person shall sell any suit or costume to which this Act applies unless the same is branded as prescribed.

Penalty: Ten pounds.”.
