**AN ACT to amend the Wheat Industry Stabilization Act 1974.**

[5 May 1976]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1—(1)** This Act may be cited as the *Wheat Industry Stabilization Act 1976*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Wheat Industry Stabilization Act 1974* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

## Commencement.

**2** This Act shall commence, or shall be deemed to have commenced, as the case requires, on the date on which the *Wheat Export Charge Act 1976* of the Commonwealth comes into operation.

## Definitions.

**3** Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of “wheat products” and substituting the following definition:—

“ ‘wheat products’ has the same meaning as in the *Wheat Export Charge Act 1974-1976* of the Commonwealth or, if that Act is amended, as in that Act as amended.”
