from amongst its members in such manner as such Association shall determine; and all such members so appointed to the Board of The Hutchins School shall hold office for five years and thereafter until their successors are appointed; provided that no member of the lastmentioned Board shall hold office for more than ten consecutive years.

(2) The Hutchins School Old Boys' Association shall consist of such old scholars of The Hutchins School and other persons who shall have become members of that Association.".

Old Scholars' Association and the Hutchins School Fund. 5 Section forty of the Principal Act is amended by omitting all the words from the beginning of that section down to and including the word "Association", second occurring, in that section.

Appointment and dismissal of headmasters.

6 Section forty-three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph VIII. the words "and shall be a graduate of a university within the British Empire.".
