AN ACT to amend the War Service Land Settlement Act 1950.

[15 December 1976]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *War Service Land Settlement Act 1976*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *War Service Land Settlement Act 1950*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section 35 of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

“(2) The provisions of subsection (1) do not apply to a body corporate to which a disposition of an estate of freehold or term of years in a holding is made with the approval in writing of the Board if all moneys owing in respect of the holding to the Board and to such other persons as the Board may direct are paid on or before the completion of the disposition.”.
