A BILL

To repeal the *Eastern Railway Construction Act* 1971 and to facilitate the disposal of land acquired for the purposes thereof.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Eastern Railway Construction (Repeal) Act* 1982. Short title.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent. Commencement.

10 (3) In this Act the *Eastern Railway Construction Act* 1971 is called the Principal Act. Principal Act No. 8235.

2. The Principal Act is hereby repealed. Repeal of Act No. 8235.

15 3. Notwithstanding the repeal by this Act of the Principal Act the provisions of section 10 of the Principal Act shall continue to apply to and with respect to the sale or transfer of any land acquired by the Melbourne and Metropolitan Board of Works for the purposes of the line of railway referred to in the Principal Act. Transitional.
