A BILL

To amend the Zoological Gardens Act 1967.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):-

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Zoological Gardens short title. (Amendment) Act 1973.
- (2) In the Act the Zoological Gardens Act 1967 is called the Principal Act No. 7518. Principal Act.

2. For paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of section 5 of the Amendment of No. 7518 s. 5. 10 Principal Act there shall be substituted the following paragraph:—

- "(a) a person appointed by the Governor in Council on the nomination of the Minister for Conservation;".
- 3. Section 14 of the Principal Act is hereby amended as Amendment of No. 7518 s. 14. 15 follows:—
 - (a) Before the word "Subject" there shall be inserted the expression "(1)";
 - (b) After paragraph (b) there shall be inserted the following sub-section :--
- "(2) The Board may with the consent of the Power to 20 Governor in Council from time to time borrow such borrow moneys, sums as the Board thinks necessary for the purposes

of promoting public interest in and increasing public attendances at the Zoological Gardens upon the security of the charges and other revenues coming to the hands of the Board pursuant to this Act but so that the aggregate liability of the Board 5 in respect of such borrowed moneys shall not at any time exceed \$500,000."
