Hairdressers Registration (Repeal) Bill EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 cites the purpose of the Act.

Clause 2 provides for the Act to come into operation on 1 January 1986.

Clause 3 provides the relevant definitions for the purposes of the Act.

Clause 4 repeals the Hairdressers Registration Act 1958.

Clause 5 transfers moneys held by the Board to the Consolidated Fund.

Clause 6 transfers the Board staff to the Public Service with their entitlements protected.

Clause 7 provides the Board's staff superannuation entitlements by giving them an option of remaining in their existing scheme or transferring to the State Superannuation Scheme. They are given one month from the operation of this Act to decide.
