APPROPRIATION (CONSOLIDATED FUND) ACT (No. 1) 1997

No. 14 of 1997

AN ACT to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Fund certain sums for the services and purposes of the year ending 30 June 1998.

[Assented to 29 June 1997.]

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act (No. 1) 1997.*

s. 2

Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Issue and application of moneys

- **3.** (1) The sum of \$5 520 916 000 shall be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Fund as supply granted to Her Majesty for the year from 1 July 1997 to 30 June 1998.
- (2) The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Bill (No. 2)* 1997.

Appropriation of Purpose

4. The sum of \$5 520 916 000 granted by section 3 as supply to Her Majesty and is appropriated from the Consolidated Fund for the recurrent services and purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
