AN ACT to amend the Government Railways Act, 1904-1960.

[Assented to 13th November, 1963.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Government Railways Act Amendment Act, 1963.* Short title and citation.

(2) In this Act the Government Railways Act, 1904-1960, is referred to as the principal Act. Reprinted. Approved for reprint, 17th May, 1963.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Government Railways Act, 1904-1963.

3. Section seventy-six of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the passage, "Western Australian Government Railways and Tramways Employees' Death Benefit and Endowment Fund"—

- (a) in lines nine, ten and eleven of subsection (1);
- (b) in lines six, seven and eight of subsection (5); and
- (c) in lines two, three and four of subsection (6),

the passage, "Western Australian Government Railways Employees' Death Benefit and Endowment Fund Incorporated".
