

HAIRDRESSERS REGISTRATION.

AN ACT to amend the Hairdressers Registration Act, 1946-1965.

[Assented to 8th November, 1968.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Hairdressers Registration Act Amendment Act, 1968.*

(2) In this Act the Hairdressers Registration Act, 1946-1965, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Hairdressers Registration Act, 1946-1968.

2. Subsection (4) of section fourteen of the principal Act is amended as to paragraph (a) by deleting the passage “, who is practising hairdressing”, in line two.
