

MONEY LENDERS.

No. 111 of 1970.

AN ACT to amend the Money Lenders Act, 1912-1962.

[Assented to 8th December, 1970.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Money Lenders Act Amendment Act, 1970.*

(2) In this Act the Money Lenders Act, 1912-1962, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Money Lenders Act, 1912-1970.

Commence-
ment.

2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy.

(Interpre-
tation.)

3. The definition "Interest" is amended by adding after the word "fees" being the last word in the definition the words "nor any sum lawfully agreed to be paid on account of duties or fees payable under any Act".
