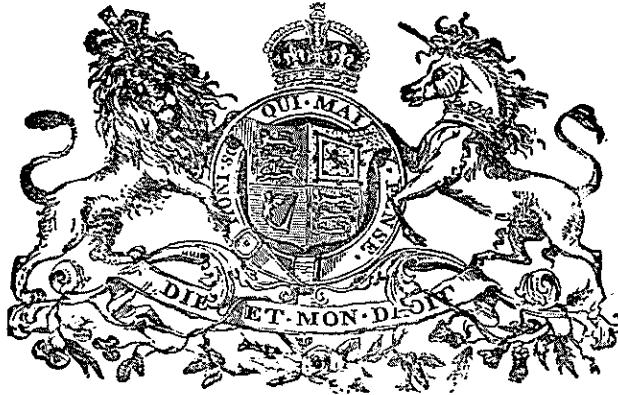

AN ACT for the Closing of portions of Larkin Street, in the Municipality of Kanowna.

[Assented to 21st November, 1904.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. All rights of way in and over such portions of Larkin Street, in the Municipality of Kanowna, as are described in the Schedule to this Act shall henceforth cease and determine; and it shall be lawful for His Majesty to deal with the said portions of the said street as if the same had never been any portion of a public street or subject to such rights.

Abolition of certain thoroughfare.

SCHEDULE.

THOSE portions of Larkin Street, in the Municipality of Kanowna, hereinafter described, namely:—

1. Bounded by lines starting from a point 64 links North from the North-West corner of Kanowna Lot 60 and extending North 71·3 links; thence East 2 chains 50 links, South 71·3 links, and West 2 chains 50 links to the starting point.

2. Bounded by lines starting from a point situate 64 links North from the North-West corner of Kanowna Lot 41 and extending North 71·3 links, East 2 chains 50 links, South 71·3 links, and West 2 chains 50 links to the starting point.
