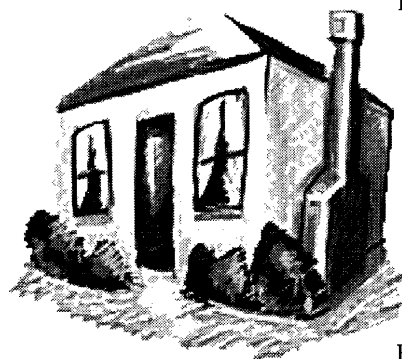
## Kidz Internet quiz

The ABA children's quiz, 'How net savvy are you?' closed on 20 March 1999. Part of the

ABA's Australian Families Guide to the

Internet, the quiz was based on children's knowledge of their 'house rules' for using the Internet. The quiz asked children to submit their own rules, and the successful entrant has won a year's subscription to KAHooTZ — a club just for kids— which was donated by the Australian Children's Television Foundation, Telstra and Hewlett Packard.

This was the second time the ABA has run the quiz. The first was in conjunction with the



launch of Online Australia Day in November 1998.

The responses to the two quizzes provide insight into the types of house rules parents set. The need to have adult supervision was the most common rule. Children said they had time limits imposed and missed a turn on the computer if they argued about vacating the computer when their time was up. Entrants knew not to talk to people who were, 'mean and rude', or, as one girl replied, 'to older boys'. The children also knew it was important to 'have fun' on the Internet.

The ABA wishes to thank all the entrants and the prize donators for making this a successful quiz.
