A BILL

INTITULED

AN ACT

To amend the *Sunday Entertainment Act* 1967.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Sunday Entertainment (Evidence) Act* 1969. Short title.

(2) The *Sunday Entertainment Act* 1967 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act. Principal Act No. 7634 as amended by No. 7677.

10 2. After section 12 of the Principal Act there shall be inserted the following section :—

“ 12A. Upon any proceedings for a contravention of or failure to comply with any condition limitation or restriction to which a permit issued under this Act is or was at any time subject a document purporting to be a copy of the permit and bearing a certificate purporting to be signed by the Under Secretary that the document is a true copy of the permit shall be *prima facie* evidence of the permit and of any condition limitation or restriction to which the permit is or was subject.”
