

# Shop Trading (Amendment) Bill

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

*Clause 1* provides that the purpose of the Act is to repeal provisions requiring shops and market sites to be registered.

*Clause 2* provides that section 5 came into operation on 17 February 1988 and that the rest of the Act comes into operation on 1 January 1989.

*Clause 3* provides that the Principal Act is the *Shop Trading Act 1987*.

*Clause 4* provides that various sections of the Principal Act be amended to provide for the removal of references to registration and makes other consequential amendments.

*Clause 5* provides for a minor amendment of section 32 of the Act.
